
Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

Emission Reduction Targets

As part of its ongoing journey towards Net Zero, E & E Accessories has strengthened its commitment by aligning with the Science Based Target initiative. The company has set ambitious absolute emission reduction targets, aiming for significant progress by 2030.

- The scope 1 & 2 emissions will be reduced by the 50% by 2027 with a primary focus on natural gas emission & electricity - related emissions.
- The scope 3 emissions will be reduced by 50% by 2027 from the factors of supply chain, material use & waste disposal.
